The Arts Club has a history—and a future—of never being content with the status quo and of always striving forward from its founding to today. Our very name derives from our 1958 origins as a private club for visual artists, musicians, and actors. From such humble, and nonthespian, beginnings the Club expanded to become a small theatre company. In 1964, a group of twenty or so local theatre-practitioners and theatre-lovers banded together to convert an attic above a pub into a performance space: our original home, the Seymour Street Stage.

Distinctively, the Arts Club was created by local artists for the local community—that symbiotic dynamic continues today. From our origins as a small, scrappy pub theatre to our current form as one of Canada's largest theatrical institutions, we have spent more than six decades fostering pathways and opportunities for artists and craftspeople, creating a framework within which art can flourish in our city.

In our next (61st) season, art will indeed flourish on our stages! At our Stanley Industrial Alliance Stage, our season-ticket series includes the hit musicals Jersey Boys and Waitress, the swashbuckling The Three Musketeers, the emotional journey of Cambodian Rock Band, and the impactful Casey and Diana. 

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About the Authors



FRANK LOFSSER

One of America's great composer/ lyricists, Frank Loesser began his songwriting career during the Depression as a lyricist, contributing songs to Broadway revues and nightclub acts. His

work with composer Irving Actman in the 1936 revue The Illustrator's Show led to a songwriting contract in Hollywood, where he spent the next eleven years working with such composers AHoagy Carmichael. Some of his film songs from that period include "Two Sleepy People," "Jingle Jangle Jingle" and "I Don't Want To Walk Without You." The first song for which Loesser wrote both words and music was "Praise The Lord And Pass The Ammunition," written during his World War II service. His Hollywood work after the war included the hit songs "Spring Will Be A Little Late This Year," "A Slow Boat To China," and the 1949 Oscar-winning song "Baby, It's Cold Outside." In 1948 Loesser was approached by fledgling Broadway producers Cy Feuer and Ernest Martin to write music and lyrics to George Abbott's libretto for an adaptation of the classic Brandon Thomas play Charley's Aunt. The new musical, which starred Ray Bolger, was called Where's Charley? and was a hit. This led to Loesser's next show, the hugely influential and successful Guys & Dolls in 1950, also produced by Feuer and Martin, with a script by Abe Burrows and Jo Swerling. In 1956 Loesser wrote the libretto, music and lyrics for his next show. The Most Happy Fella, adapted from Sidney Howard's play, They Knew What They Wanted. This

impressive score contains over 30 musical numbers and makes extensive use of operatic techniques and forms, including recitative, arias, duets, trios and choral numbers. In 1960 he provided the score and was co-librettist for *Greenwillow*. In 1961, Loesser wrote the score for the Pulitzer Prize-winning *How To Succeed In Business Without Really Trying*. His last show, *Pleasures And Palaces*, closed in 1965 during out-of-town try-outs. For more information on Frank Loesser, please visit his official website: frankloesser.com.



JO SWERLING

Born in Russia in 1897, Jo Swerling was a playwright, screenwriter and vaudeville sketch writer. Mr. Swerling's long career began as a reporter and feature writer in New York and Chicago.



ABE BURROWS

After studying to be a doctor and an accountant, Abe Burrows had a career in sales before becoming a successful radio script writer and writer/performer of musical parody numbers. His first

Broadway libretto was Guys & Dolls, co-written with Jo Swerling, with a score by Frank Loesser. Among the musicals for which he provided librettos are Make A Wish, Can-Can and Silk Stockings (both with scores by Cole Porter), Say, Darling, and How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying (which he also directed; score by Frank Loesser). His non-musical plays include Cactus Flower (wrote and directed) and Forty Carats (directed).



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Director's Notes

"I'm not bitter. Why should I be bitter? I'm thrilled to death with life."

—Johnny Cash

I grew up, in rural Saskatchewan, in a world of country music, blue jeans, and cowboy hats. Not as a statement but as an assumption, a uniform—daily work clothes. Johnny Cash belongs to every rink, every Boxing Day dance, every shop radio of my childhood. In thinking about that nostalgia, I began to crack open the nostalgia of this play. *Ring of Fire* is not the complete life story of Johnny Cash...but his life is inside it. In reading and listening to biographies and interviews with the man himself, I found in them a commonality in the search for meaning. A wonder that I think many of us share about what a life adds up to. Every choice, every action has a ripple that contributes to our identity and to our mark on the world.

We as the creative team decided to launch off from this idea of our commonality, and of the joy that can come from this examination. This incredible team of actor/musicians leapt into the void with us, playing with music, time, space, found objects, and this beautiful sketch of a life told mostly through song and movement. What is the curated junk shop of our identity and which elements rise to the top as being the ones that really matter?

We built this piece as an ensemble, and we invite you tonight to join us in our ensemble. To bring your own memories, your own nostalgia—the successes and the misses—to experiencing this music we all love deeply, perhaps in a new way.


