KRIS KRINGLE: Male, 60s+. Kind old man who believes he is Santa Claus. He embodies all of the classic characteristics of the jolly, friendly, warm-hearted icon.

DORIS WALKER: Female, late 20's-mid 40's. Special Event Coordinator for Macy's Department Store. She is a driven career woman and free thinker who has recently divorced. Hard-working and cynical.

*SUSAN WALKER: Female, between 8-13. Daughter to Dorris. She is wise beyond her years and a self-sufficient city girl. Also plays GIRL.

FRED GAILEY: A handsome Military Captain mustering out into civilian life. Smart, hopeful, and warm.

SHELLHAMMER: Male, 30's-40's. An aggressive but somewhat bungling junior executive and the head of Public Relations. Also plays the **JUDGE** and **POSTMAN**.

R. H MACY: Male, 40's-60s. The boss of Macy's. Very concerned with public opinion. Also plays **FATHER**, **PIERCE**, **BAILIFF**, and **LOUIE**.

GIMBEL: Male, 30's+. The Owner of Macy's #1 competitor- Gimbel's. Also plays **PARAD SANTA, SAWYER,** and **CHARLIE.**

ALFRED: Male, 40's+. Kris's co-worker at Macy's. Also plays **MARA**.

MRS.SHELLHAMMER: Female, 30's-40's. Shellhammer's wife. Also plays MOTHER and STENOGRAPHER.

***TOMMY:** Male, between 8-13. Mara's young son who testifies in Kris' trial. Also plays **MORTIMER**.
