So much has changed in this last year. Last fall, we saw a small and steadfast group attend our one-person productions. However, at the start of our small holiday production, we learned that we had to cancel all in person performances of *The Twelve Dates of Christmas*. This shut down was a major blow to our team, who was doing its best to keep theatre alive. But soon after, creativity and determination prevailed. We began a series of audio plays. The *Listen to this Audio Play Series* was born and became an incubator for developing new Canadian plays. We would bring theatre to our patrons, even while our stages were dark.

As soon as we were able, we successfully brought our one person shows back with *I, Claudia* at the Newmont Stage and *Beneath Spring Hill* at Granville Island. They turned out to be an excellent training opportunity for us to adjust to the new COVID protocols while rebuilding our community.

My time as Chair was different than I expected it to be. I had planned on a busy social calendar, but instead it was a time for the organization to do some self-reflection and think about its business model and its values. The Arts Club invested in accessibility and began the journey to become a more inclusive operation. Leading the organization through this work was incredibly rewarding and I am grateful that I had the opportunity to be involved.

While there were fewer performances, the Education department was busier than ever and found new ways to engage school groups virtually, while also building new partnerships with other not-for-profit organizations in the community. Programs now offered virtually had record breaking applications and we learned many lessons from our online experiences that we will carry forward.

The Artistic team continued to offer programs for local artists such as the Company-in-Residence and the Emerging Playwright's Unit, while also developing several new plays.

As I wrap up my time as Chair, I want to thank my fellow Directors for their commitment to the Arts Club. Their time and energy is invaluable and particularly over the last 20 months when their guidance and leadership was so greatly needed.

Thank you to the staff for their courage and perseverance and to our funders, including the three levels of government, who provided annual operating grants and COVID relief funding.

Lastly, I would like to thank our patrons and donors who were the lifeline to the Arts Club during a time when we could not gather.

Thank you for your generosity and your belief in our work.

Ashlie Corcoran ARTISTIC DIRECTOR



The 2020/2021 season was certainly one like no other. Thinking back to last autumn, I remember how excited we all were to be able to create live theatre once again—even if on a smaller scale. We had spent the first six months of the pandemic looking for ways to connect with our audience, create with local artists, and provide meaningful employment to our staff.

As public restrictions began to ease, we welcomed audiences back for our Fall Trio—three one-person plays with micro audiences of 50. Both in person (socially distanced) and virtual, the show was finally able to go on! Then, when COVID-19 cases began to rise in the early winter, we once again had to stop producing in person works, a disappointing but necessary step.

When we were unable to gather, we knew that we had to connect with our audiences in other ways—ways which stretched us, and taught us new skills. We were drawn to telling local stories through audio—an intimate form of storytelling which invites audience members to use their imagination and participate in the creation of the tale—much like live theatre. With these values driving us, we launched *Listen to This: Audio Plays*—a season of four world premiere audio plays, written by Silver Commission and Emerging Playwrights' Unit writers. Additionally, we commissioned Andrew Kushnir to create the first Arts Club podcast, *This is Something Else: Consciously Eclectic Histories of the Arts Club*, a project that took a distinct approach to history—focusing less on dates and events, and casting an eye (and ear) to the complex relationships between people, places and big ideas.

We were finally able to return to small shows once again in the summer of 2021. I am proud to report that during this time of economic hardship for our freelance community, the above activities and our new play development programs allowed us to hire 215 artists in the 2020/2021 season. In addition to this artistic programming, we launched *Write from the Wings* which invited local writers to use empty rehearsal rooms, stages, dressing rooms and lobbies at the BMO Theatre Centre for their own personal writing retreats, providing a space to inspire creativity after months of being stuck at home. As well, we continued our journey to make the Arts Club a more inclusive, accessible and equitable company. You can read more about this this work on page 12. Our Education department was also busy, slowly bringing back the Musical Theatre Intensive and Actors' Intensive programs, as well as continuing to get creative with workshops over Zoom.

Reflecting back on all of this activity I am struck by how much our incredible team at the Arts Club managed to accomplish. I feel so lucky to get to work with everyone—from our FOH and Box Office teams, to Marketing, Development, Education, Administration, Finance, and of course the craftspeople and artists in our Production and Artistic teams. I am also so grateful to the freelance artists we collaborated with this season, to our indomitable Board of Directors led by the brilliant Bryan Mabee, and to my partner in crime—Peter Cathie White. No matter how difficult this pandemic year got, Peter could always find a way to bring humour to the situation, as well as his razer sharp intelligence, and tenacious spirit.

And of course, I am so thankful to our donors and supporters who stood by us. We wouldn't have gotten here without you. I am blown away by our community's support and loyalty. Thank you, from the bottom of my heart.

Onwards to 2021/2022.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



As I write this we have just opened *Dolly Parton's Smoky Mountain Christmas Carol* to full audiences at our flagship venue. This opening night could not have happened without the work of all our teams in 2020/2021 to ensure we could rebuild and begin our journey back to full-scale houses and productions.

Reopening has been 22 months in the making and it felt so good to be back doing what we do best. It takes a village to put on a production. It not only needs the artists onstage and backstage and in our various production areas, but also the work of our Facilities, Education, Development, Marketing, Finance, IT and Database, and Guest Services teams to ensure we have the funds to do it and the people to see it.

I want to give my personal and heart-felt thanks to every single Arts Clubber for getting us through the 2020/2021 season. Without the work done by Arts Club employees, without their dedication and passion, we would not have reopened once again. Their work paved the way for our future and I'll remain ever-grateful for that.

I'd also like to extend our sincere thanks to the Federal Government for recognizing the need for the Canadian Emergency Wage Subsidy for companies like us that saw over a 90% drop in revenue, and provided resiliency funding through the Canada Council for the Arts. The BC Provincial Government also provided relief funds early in this crisis and continued this support this season with much needed funding. I am also grateful to the City of Vancouver for continuing our annual operating grant.

Our donors also generously supported our activity this season. We could not have staged the five productions we did in the 2020/2021 season without their contributions. Their support gave us the will and strength to continue through this hard-fought season. We truly would have faced a massive deficit without their buoyant generosity and their desire to ensure this local theatre company continues to remain vibrant in this community.

In addition to thanking my fellow Arts Clubbers, I am also grateful for the support from our volunteer board members and, in particular, Bryan Mabee, who became our board chair in Dec 2019 and has dealt with the pandemic's effect on our business for almost his entire tenure. Thank you Bryan for your faith in us. Thank you board members for your support. Your stewardship has set us up for what promises to be a brighter future. Thank you also to our Foundation board for your support and work this season to manage and grow our endowment for our future prosperity.

Ashlie and I will forever be grateful for the support we have received and know all of it is crucial to this company's future. And I will always be humbled by Ashlie and her unwavering support for our employees, our art, and our artists. We were one of the few theatre company's in this country who staged work for live audiences during this pandemic season. It was small by mandate, but it was there, on our stages and steeped in beauty. I am immensely proud of that. We all should be.

PLAYS: IN PERSON & VIRTUALLY STREAMED

With the onset of COVID-19, the Arts Club was required to close the doors on our three venues, thus cancelling 24 planned productions and eliminating employment for over 600 artists and staff members. Since then, we have sought ways to continue creating meaningful art, and over the season hired 215 artists.

Despite 2020/2021's rollercoaster of lockdowns and partial re-opening, we were happy to be able to offer five one-person shows, for live audiences and streaming, from our Granville Island and Newmont Stages. These imaginative and soul-stirring productions brought us from an inner city school in NYC, all the way to a travelling circus. We went on bad dates with Mary, remembered being a pre-teen with Claudia, and found courage and community with Maurice Ruddick. While these productions were small, we were grateful to be one of the few theatre company's in this country who were able to stage work for live audiences during this pandemic season.



LISTEN TS THIS

Audio Play Series

Our audio play series *Listen to This* featured four original Canadian scripts, all commissioned by the Arts Club. The creation of this program allowed us to honour existing contracts with commissioned playwrights and also initiate new adaptations of stage scripts developed in our Emerging Playwrights' Unit. Each script was given a half-day development workshop and then rehearsed and recorded over two days. The audio plays were directed by Artistic Director Ashlie Corcoran and Associate Artistic Director, Rachel Peake.



Implementing this program required us to learn a new approach to creating our work: we adapted our Stanley Industrial Alliance Stage as a recording studio and gathered the necessary skills in producing, recording and then disseminating digital audio. The results were so successful and rewarding that we decided to continue the initiative for the 2021/2022 season (*Listen to This: Series 2*), creating four more audio plays while we start to re-engage with live performance production.











THIS IS SOMETHING ELSE: CONSCIOUSLY ECLECTIC HISTORIES OF THE ARTS CLUB

This Is Something Else: Consciously Eclectic Histories of the Arts Club is a 5-part limited podcast series travelling through more than 50 years of Vancouver's theatre scene. Created and hosted by documentary theatremaker Andrew Kushnir, the project takes a unique approach to history. As Andrew puts it in his first episode: "This series is not a eulogy. It's not a legacy project or promotional piece. It's not the careful work of a historian or journalist. And it's not a walk down memory lane either. This is something else." Putting together multiple perspectives into conversation with one another—at times, in quirky ways—Andrew explores how the past can speak to our present moment in as vivid terms as possible.

SILVER COMMISSIONS PROJECT

Thanks to the generosity of donors Stan and Kathy Hamilton, the Arts Club has been offering the Silver Commissions program since 2006. This initiative provides funding for playwrights to write and develop new plays. An average development period for a script is three years, which includes dramaturgical support, development workshops with actors, and both public and private readings to help in the realization of the playwright's vision. During the 2020/2021 season, we had six scripts by local playwrights (Tai Amy Grauman, Hiro Kanagawa, Amy Lee Lavoie & Omari Newton, the Mom's the Word Collective, Christine Quintana, and Michele Riml & Michael St. John Smith) in active development.

EMERGING PLAYWRIGHTS' UNIT

An initiative to create deeper relationships with playwrights, the Unit provides much-needed development support and mentorship to four emerging playwrights, including the guidance of a dramaturge and the support of their peers. The 2021 cohort was made up of Katie Gartlan-Close, Alexandra Lainfiesta, Jenny Larson-Quiñones and Kesley Kanatan Wavey. The Emerging Playwright's Unit was made possible through the support of longtime donor and Foundation board member Bonnie Mah.

NATIONAL CREATION FUND

One of the most highly anticipated commissions as part of our new play development is *Forgiveness* by the Governor General's Literary Awardwinning playwright, Hiro Kanagawa. Co-commissioned by the Arts Club Theatre Company (as a part of its Silver Commissions Project) and Theatre Calgary, this project received major support from the National Creation Fund in the 2020/2021 season, allowing it to receive intensive development.

WRITE FROM THE WINGS

This season we ran a very successful pilot program during the month of May called Write from the Wings. This program invited writers from the Lower Mainland to use a spot in our theatre spaces for two weeks for their own self-directed writing retreats. We had writers scattered around our venues in dressing rooms, on stages, in our lobbies, and rehearsal halls. Many of these writers are also theatre artists, actors, designers, directors, creators, facilitators, filmmakers, and poets—and many of them had been out of work for over a year. It was a pleasure to host them in our spaces and to give them excitement and creativity in these trying times.

Since this very successful first month, we saw a need in the community and continued the program to allow writers to use our Newmont Theatre dressing rooms when they were not being used. The program has welcomed over 50 writers. It's fostered an open door relationship and an ongoing conversation between our organization and the amazingly talented creators in our city.

Over a period of 4 weeks we welcomed 39 local writers into our spaces:

74% had either never worked for the Arts Club, or had only worked for us once

50% identified as coming from a marginalized community

EDUCATION & OUTREACH

As part of our mission to inspire and nurture artists and audiences, we offer educational programs and outreach initiatives for individuals and groups of all ages, including students, educators, artists, and the broader public. The 2020/2021 season was a challenging one with COVID-19 restrictions, however, we were still able to continue to broaden and diversify our programming in order to deliver meaningful and effective learning opportunities in Metro Vancouver and across the province of BC. Our programming focuses on the four key pillars of diversity, accessibility, fostering creativity, and building communities.

DIVERSITY

It is imperative that our diverse communities are reflected in the educational programming that we offer at the Arts Club. Some highlights in the 2020/2021 season included:

- Hosting an online professional development day for BC teachers that focused on Anti-Racism in the classroom. Guest speakers included, Tai Amy Grauman, Omari Newton, and Nitasha Rajoo
- Designing panels attached to our productions that explore issues such as cultural representation in arts and historical perspectives from different vantage points
- Developing and nurturing partnerships with organizations that represent equity-seeking communities (Jumpstart Refugee Talent, Afro News, Sage Foundation, and Ethós Lab) with the goal of finding ways to lower barriers to theatre education and employment in the arts
- Providing workshops exploring the transferrable skills that can be gained from drama exercises to build confidence through body language awareness, role-playing, and vocalization
- Regular workshops for families from equity-seeking communities to provide a safe place to gather and learn together through online drama activities.

ACCESSIBILITY

Removing barriers and providing opportunities to people who may not typically have access to theatre has become a strong focus for the Arts Club's Education Department this season. We are proud to have partnered with VocalEye since 2010 to provide described performances for those living with vision loss. We have also been developing and offering relaxed performances as an inclusive experience designed to welcome patrons of all ages and sensitivities who may not be comfortable with the traditional theatre environment.

Some of the additional ways that the Arts Club has been able to improve accessibility in our programs, materials, and staff awareness in the 2020/2021 season has been by:

- Hiring Accessibility Coordinator, Amy Amantea to audit our spaces, online and printed materials, external and external communication, and our programs
- Providing Accessibility training sessions for teachers and staff, including sighted guide training
- Offering programs that are free for participants, such as our LEAP and adult online courses
- Offering subsidized spots in all of our educational programming for folks who face financial barriers
- Offering our Grant Burnyeat Student Series to all Vancouver Secondary schools, which provides 30 complimentary tickets to each school. This included access to our streamed audio plays.

FOSTERING CREATIVITY

The Arts Club offers unique educational programming that focusses on creating work by sharing stories and working with themes that are socially and culturally relevant. Our Creative Teens program gives students in grades 7–12 an opportunity to explore creative play-making in a collaborative environment. This program emphasizes student agency and self-reflection all within the framework of developing their own piece of theatre drawn from their own stories and experiences. In 2021, we adjusted our program so that it was offered as an online experience.

Our LEAP (Learning Early About Playwriting) program offers instruction to students who are interested in learning how to develop their own scripts. Offered at no cost to the participants, students receive feedback from theatre professionals and have their plays workshopped and presented to the public in staged readings. As with Creative Teens, this program was delivered successfully online.

Since COVID forced many of our programs online, we felt it was imperative that we still reach out to our patrons and communities to provide spaces for engagement with theatre. We created the Acting 101, 102, and Community Creates classes for adults. These free programs introduced us to a whole new community of theatre lovers and gave participants an opportunity to explore acting through storytelling.

Other programs that took place this year included the Musical Theatre Intensive, Actors Intensive, Student Workshop Experience, Sunday Salons and Tuesday Talkbacks.

BUILDING COMMUNITIES

An important aspect of all our programming is providing educational opportunities that both build and strengthen communities. As theatre has a unique way of developing empathy and reinforcing social connections, the Arts Club has been developing initiatives that reach into our communities. Here's a quick look into our outreach initiatives:

- Worked with Britannia Secondary to offer online production assistance for their drama showcases
- Partnered with Bard on the Beach to create an online program called "Beyond the Box" for schoolteachers to examine the benefits and challenges of online learning
- Developed our education social media accounts to be able to strengthen our links to our communities.



GRANT BURNYEAT STUDENT SERIES

The Grant Burnyeat Student Series is an initiative developed in collaboration with longtime theatre supporter and former Arts Club board member Justice Grant Burnyeat. The intention of this program is twofold: to provide meaningful opportunities for youth to participate in the arts on a more frequent basis and to strengthen relationships between the Arts Club and public Vancouver secondary schools and youth organizations.

ANNUAL WRITING COMPETITION 2020/2021

The Grant Burnyeat Annual Writing Competition invites students from Vancouver secondary schools to write an essay that considers the following questions:

- 1. Why is it important that students have access to live theatre?
- 2. What contribution does live theatre make to our society?
- 3. What was it about a production that you saw that meant the most to you?

The student submissions go through an adjudication process. Eight essays were submitted in June 2021 and two essays that best demonstrated considerable thought and insight regarding the impact of live theatre on youth today were selected to receive cash prizes.

The first-place essay writer, Daphne Jung from Killarney Secondary, was awarded \$750. The second place writer, Russell B. from Eric Hamber Secondary received \$250. The winners were celebrated in a special online event in July, where they were invited to read their essays in front of a live virtual audience. A recording of the event can be found on the Arts Club YouTube channel.

BILL MILLERD ARTIST FUND

Supporting the Growth of Canadian Theatre



The Bill Millerd Artist Fund was named for and established by the Arts Club's Artistic Director Emeritus. In the early 1960s, the Koerner Foundation awarded Bill a grant to assist him in attending the National Theatre School.

After 46 years as Artistic Managing Director, Bill wanted to gift similar life-changing opportunities to other theatre artists. He seeded an endowment fund with a significant donation and was joined by over a thousand generous donors including the Department of Canadian Heritage.

The purpose of the Bill Millerd Artist Fund is to assist theatre artists and arts workers with expenses related to unique opportunities that will advance their artistic development, such as professional development workshops, classes, mentorships, apprenticeships, residencies with theatre companies, or tuition costs to pursue professional training.




