On **Saturday, October 3**, the Granville Island Stage will open its doors to 50 patrons, marking the first time the venue has welcomed an audience since its closure due to COVID-19. Millerd and Cuffling will reminisce about the early days of the Arts Club, and treat the audience to some of their career hits. A Q&A session with the audience will follow. Tickets are available for \$100 each.

A digital stream will also be available for \$20. Digital ticket buyers will receive a link at 7:30 PM on October 3, which they may watch at their own convenience over the next 48 hours.

"We're so thrilled to welcome Bill and Bernard back to the Granville Island Stage to relive some of their favourite Arts Club memories," said Artistic Director **Ashlie Corcoran** of the event. "At a time when we are longing to share the power of theatre with our audience, we are excited to come together once again and dive into the Arts Club's history."

The Arts Club has implemented <u>numerous safety measures</u> to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health and welfare of patrons, artists, staff, and volunteers. Productions and events will be staged in adherence to safety guidelines established by the B.C. government.

All proceeds from this event will go towards not only bringing theatre back to the Arts Club's stages, but also youth and education initiatives and new play development programs.
