VANCOUVER, B.C. (March 6, 2023)—Song and story are the key ingredients for the world premiere production of the Métis cabaret *Rubaboo*, playing March 30–April 30 at the Granville Island Stage.

Like the Michif word the title is derived from, *Rubaboo* is an intimate and moving celebration of Métis culture, all guided by **Andrea Menard**, the award-winning powerhouse Métis performer and Vancouver-based artist. Come along as Menard's lyrical voice and intricate storytelling mix with the sounds of drums and guitars to share stories of reconciliation, frustration, and love. This grand musical feast is a powerful journey of unity and resilience, one for everyone to take part in and enjoy.

Of the piece, creator and star Menard said, "Rubaboo is a musical cabaret of stories and songs that share my love for the Métis people and culture. It's a journey that takes you into the heart of reconciliation. If you know me, I'm all about healing our collective wounds through gentleness, magic, beauty, humour, and honesty."

Artistic Director **Ashlie Corcoran** said, "From the moment I heard Andrea's music, I was immediately hooked. Her storytelling is rhythmic, moving, and celebratory. I am certain our audiences will be captivated by Andrea's grace, wisdom, imagination, and fierce wit."

ABOUT THE PLAYWRIGHT

Andrea Menard is an accomplished Métis singer-songwriter, actor, speaker, wellness trainer, retreat host, and the founder of the Sacred Feminine Learning Lodge. Menard is an influencer in feminine leadership and was named one of the Women Executive Network's (WXN) Canada's Most Powerful Women: Top 100 Award Winner in 2020. One of the stars of the Netflix series *Blackstone*, Andrea is a five-time Gemini-nominated actress and a 15-time music award winner. Menard has released four award-winning albums, a symphony show, and two television programs. Her TEDx Talk called "Silent No More" has reached over 126,000 views. She has performed for royalty, prime ministers, governor-generals, residential school Survivors, families of the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, and even sang her song "Peace" to the world's NATO generals. Born in Manitoba, Menard is a proud member of the Métis Nation of Canada. She carries the name *Skooteah Equahh*, which means "Fire Woman" in Anishinaabe and the Cree name *Notigwew Yutin*, which means "Grandmother Wind."
