#### ABOUT THE MOM'S THE WORD COLLECTIVE

Mom's the Word has had a full gestation period going back to conception in the spring of 1993. Six professional actors found themselves fully employed but ironically unpaid in the shocking role of "new mothers." They began meeting once a week to create a piece of theatre they hoped would explode some of the mommy myths they'd encountered. There had been lots written about the glory of motherhood but little of the gory bits. They talked, they laughed, they cried, they whined, they complained, they laughed some more but they didn't get anything down on paper. With a deadline looming, in the tradition of oral history, they remembered each other's stories and decided on which stories HAD to be told. Thus, was born Mom's the Word. Since then, they have gone on to create Mom's the Word: Unhinged and Mom's the Word: Nest ½ Empty. Their shows have been international successes, but all have started at the Arts Club.
